Starting with 26 candidates, the Team eventually concluded that the man God had for this position was right here, already serving faithfully at FBCS!

We created this position with an awareness that our children, youth, and families would need to be equipped and discipled to face a post-Christian culture. The position is crafted and targeted for that purpose. When we interviewed Kevin, and in subsequent conversations, I was struck by his keen awareness of that purpose reflected in the job description. In short--he gets it!

So, let's welcome Kevin! He started in the office part-time on August 29, and will join us full-time in late September. Pray for him, Kacey, and the girls as they make this transition.

And for those of you who may not know Kevin, or you were not at the meeting August 27, I've asked Kevin to introduce himself and describe his vision for launching his ministry at FBCS.

From Kevin:

I am so excited to move in obedience to God's calling on my life & serve First Baptist Church of Shallotte as the Associate Pastor for Family Life & Discipleship. God has been at work in my life, leading & preparing me for pastoral ministry since my salvation at 16. From the summer of my 8th grade year, the Lord has placed obedient and faithful Christian men in my life to disciple me. I am a product of God's grace and those faithful men who pointed me to Him through the years.

A little about me: I am 25, I am a husband to an amazing wife named Kacey, we have a 17- month-old daughter named Hazel, and we have a soon-to-arrive daughter named Hattie. I grew up in Brunswick County and graduated from West Brunswick, so I know this area well and have deep ties to this community. I attended FBCS as a youth, attended a youth rally hosted by FBCS where the Lord saved me, I was baptized at FBCS, and I participated in several FBCS mission trips and youth trips throughout my high school years. After high school, God led me to Charleston Southern University (CSU), a Christian university associated with the South Carolina Baptist



Convention. I majored in business and minored in Christian Studies, where I had the opportunity to learn under several faithful Christian professors. In my time at CSU I learned so much about God and who He is. The more I learned the more my faith increased.

The Lord has called me to full time pastoral ministry, but I wasn't always on the same page as Him regarding His will for my career. While at CSU, I fully intended to pursue a career in the business field to create a comfortable life to raise a family in. During that time, I had the opportunity to intern at Northwood Baptist. There, under Head Pastor Tommy Meador and under Executive Pastor Randy Jackson, I was intentionally discipled by each. I became heavily involved in the college ministry at Northwood, assuming a leadership role. As my time at CSU drew to an end, I considered going to seminary. The entire staff at Northwood wanted me to go to seminary and potentially serve there on staff, strongly recommending I take the leap and go. I talked myself out of it, thinking it wasn't what I was called to do. Looking back I see that I resisted the Lord's calling then, thinking it didn't fit my plan of pursing a comfortable lifestyle through the field of business.

But the Lord had other plans. He was instrumental in getting me and my wife Kacey home from Charleston, close to family as we started a family of our own. God worked out several things, from housing to jobs - all falling into place according to His plan. While it was tough saying goodbye to our church family and friends in Charleston, God had our church family at FBCS to welcome us home. Soon, I assumed a teaching role in FBCS's Young Adult class, had the opportunity to serve as a deacon, and serve as a volunteer youth leader in the absence of a youth pastor. All roles I actively served in until my recent selection as Associate Pastor of Family Life & Discipleship.

Intentional discipleship from the faithful & obedient men listed (and many more) has formed me into who I am today. I plan to continue that legacy and intentionally disciple those that come after me, being obedient to the Lord's call on my life.
